The expected outcome of this policy is simplifying and streamlining the structure of administration. It also seeks to make the process of administration more transparent and efficient. By embracing e-governance tools, the institution intends to provide quick delivery of student-based services.

5) Areas of Implementation:

5.1. Website:

5.4. Examination:

The University shall strive to provide online facilities for filling up of examination forms, reevaluation/rescrutiny orms, admit cards, declaration of results, etc.

5.5. Alumni:

In order to strengthen alumni interaction, a separate page in the University website shall be provided for Alumni registration, information on alumni activities, prominent alumni, milestones achieved by alumni, feedback and other aspects as applicable.

5.6. Responsibility :

The Registrar will be responsible for implementation of the e-Governance Policy.
