**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF GRANTS-IN-AID COMMITTEE OF THE
RASHTRIYA SANSKRIT SANSTHAN (DEEMED UNIVERSITY) HELD ON 11.08.2009.**

The meeting of the Grants-in-Aid Committee (GIAC) was held on 11-08-2009 at 11 A.M. under the Chairpersonship of Joint Secretary (Language) and Chairperson GIA Committee at the Head Quarter office of the Sansthan. The following members were present in the meeting.

Sh. P.N. Vats, Assistant Registrar (R&P) and Shri D.V. Singh Rajput, Jr. Executive (Scheme) also attended the meeting.

The Chairperson welcomed the members and the GIAC considered and made necessary recommendations and approval on the following items of the Agenda:-

Action taken report:-**Item No.1****Action Taken note on the Minutes of last meeting of the GIAC meeting held on 18.02.2009.**

- i) The action taken note was adopted by the GIAC. While preparing details of Voluntary Organization receiving financial assistance the Chairperson desired that a column may be added to the effect that (i) the year from which financial assistance is provided to the Institution, (ii) the inspection last conducted. The details of students (Girls and Boys) belonging to ST/SC/OBC specifically may also be obtained from the Institutions. The State wise list showing details of students should be prepared in descending order. No. of teachers should also be noted. A list of institutions indicating the date of last inspection should be placed in the next meeting.
- ii) Regarding item no.2 the Chairperson suggested that a list of sub-dialects and dialects should be prepared, indicating the scheduled languages.
- iii) Regarding item no.6 a status paper on Pali and Prakrit language may be prepared.
- iv) A phase wise specific time bound programme for the museum of Indian Traditions of Science and Technology should be prepared. The Director, IIIT, Hyderabad may be asked to give a time bound phase wise programme for the research project as the progress is slow. A presentation should also be made available in the Ministry. Hira Lal Memorial Lecture for Prakrit and Dr. Ambedkar Memorial Lecture for Pali should be organized at different places by rotation.

It was also decided :

1. **During the Prakrit Conference at Jaipur it was decided that a status paper on various schemes being implemented by Central Sanskrit Institutions /Organizations including private organizations is to be made by 30th October, 2009.**
2. **E-texts on Natya Shastra by Bharat Muni be popularized by sending mails to all the Indian Universities / Foreign Universities where teaching/research in Sanskrit is being done. A mailing list may be made so that the work in Sanskrit is popularized.**
3. **Computational approach in Indian Astronomy – a presentation is to be prepared.**
4. **The parameters for evaluation of a Shastra Churamani scholar should be decided. The Report about the work done by him/her should always be put up in GIAC. This should be a permanent agenda item. The parameters will be as under:**
 - a) **Contribution in teaching.**
 - b) **Contribution in research guidance.**
 - c) **Publication.**
 - d) **Editing of Manuscripts.**
5. **The details regarding organizing Bhasa Drama Festival in Somnath University may be obtained from Prof. Gautum Bhai Patel.**
6. **The form of bulk purchase of Sanskrit books may be revised.**

7. While examining proposal for grant of financial assistance to NGO they should have 20% of the proposed expenditure at their Bank account. The 80% of the approved expenditure will be sanctioned by the Sansthan.
8. For re-print of Manuscripts parameters should be prepared. Only Sansthan should publish books under the re-print scheme.

Item No.2

To consider and approve the continuation of following activities to be taken up by Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan for 2009-2010 also as approved by GIAC in its meeting held on 18.2.2009.

- i) All India Sanskrit Kavi Sammelan.
- ii) All India Sanskrit Drama Festival.

The proposal was approved. However, the members desires that the name of All India Sanskrit Kavi Sammelan be substituted as **All India Sanskrit Kavi Samvaya** and the All India Sanskrit Drama Festival may be substituted as **Akhil Bharatiya Sanskrit Natya Mahotsava**.

Item No.3

To consider and approve to establish a centre for Studies in Natya Sastra.

The proposal was approved in principle. The GIAC desires that details of the centre and the courses to be proposed there may be worked out. Vice Chancellor informed this is scheduled to be started from 2010-2011.

Item No.4

To consider and approve enhancement of grant approved for organizing seminar on Universal message of Buddhism with special reference to Pali literature.

In view of a large number of expected distinguished scholars from India and Abroad participating the conference, the enhancement was approved. Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Deemed University) will not provide airfare to foreign scholars and the funds would be utilized only for the activities permissible under rules.

Item No.5

To consider and approve renewal of financial assistance for Sanskrit teachers to the traditional Sanskrit Pathshala/Mahavidyalaya for the year 2009-2010.

The GIAC approved the renewal of the financial assistance for Sanskrit teachers to the traditional Sanskrit Pathshala/Mahavidyalaya for the year 2009-2010 as per details placed at **Annexure-I (pages 17 to 92)**. The GIAC desires that the Institutions who were not inspected for the last three years may be inspected on priority basis before releasing the grant. The new institutions will be inspected and the grant will be released only after satisfactory inspection report. The inspection will be done by campuses and completed by 31st December, 2009.

Item No.11 To consider and approve application received through respective State Govt. for appointment of one Sanskrit teachers in Govt. Schools.

The Committee consider one application received from the Sikkim Govt. and approved one Sanskrit teacher @Rs.6000/-p.m. in the Govt. School mentioned below. The sanction will be for a period of one year from 1.4.2009 to 31.3.2010.

Item No.12 To consider and approve financial assistance to Modern Teachers in Sanskrit Pathshalas/Mahavidyalayas for the year 2009-2010.

The GIA Committee approved recommendations of the Pre-scrutiny Committee meeting held on 31.7.2009 for grant of Modern teacher in Sanskrit Pathshalas/Mahavidyalayas for the year 2009-2010. The details of the proposals along with recommendations is placed at **Annexure-VI (pages 142 to 147)**. In case of new institutions they will be inspected and the grant will be released only after satisfactory inspection report.

Item No.13 To consider and recommend proposals of authors/editors for publication Grants under the scheme of Production of Sanskrit Literature.

The Committee desired to analyses the work of the author in the first instance and the proposal may be placed before next meeting of the GIAC. The Committee further decided that financial assistance for consecutive two years should not be granted to the same grantee for publications of his works. **The proposal was deferred.**

Item No.14 To consider and recommend proposals of different scholars/publishers/booksellers for purchase in bulk under the scheme of Purchase of Books on Sanskrit Literature.

The Committee desired that a separate informatory para about language of the book should also be included in the prescribed application form. Priority should be given to the proposals directly submitted by the authors. The Sansthan may monitor interest of the authors as to receipt of the royalty from the publishers in respect of the books purchased under the scheme. **Work which is original not duplication of existing work, should only be considered.**

The Committee further considered the proposals and recommended number of copies to be purchased as per **Annexure-VII (pages 148 to 159).**

Item No.15 To consider applications received from various NGO's/Sanskrit Universities/Individual for financial assistance.
