4.1.15 CORRESPONDENCE COURSE

Central Sanskrit University (Formerly Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan) is conducting two years Introductory course in Sanskrit through Correspondence Course Department for learners and lovers of Sanskrit in India and Abroad since 1970.

 (A) First year programme through Hindi and English Medium. (B) Second year programme through Hindi and English Medium.

During the year 2021-22, near about 227 Indian students & 05 foreign students have been registered in Correspondence Course. At present total of 7,259 students are studying in Correspondence Course. 25 students complete the course and got certificates in Session 2021-22.

The Central Sanskrit University had launched Distance Mode education for various traditional Sanskrit programmes through its Mukta Swadhyayapeetham in August, 2010.

Mukta Swadhyaya Peetham (The Institute of Distance Education) of Central Sanskrit University has been recognized by the Distance Education Council, IGNOU, New Delhi. (Now Distance Education Bureau, DEB University Grant Commission) The study centres of Mukta Swadhyaya Peetham at all the campuses of Central Sanskrit University are called Swadhyaya Kendra.
