Central Sanskrit University, Delhi is the nodal agency for implementing Central Schemes of Ministry of Education, Government of India for the Promotion of Sanskrit Language. Accordingly, applications are invited from interested NGOs/Voluntary Organizations/Universities/Institutions/Publishers/Individuals/Students, through online as applicable under the following **Schemes for Sanskrit Promotion**:-

* The online portal of the website for all above schemes will remain open in the entire financial year. However, applications received by 30.06.2025 as advised above will be considered for financial assistance in GIAC meeting to be held immediately thereafter. The applications received after the above date may be considered most likely in the later GIAC meeting, as per convenience of the GIAC (Chairman and Members), and subject to availability of the budgetetc.. In this regard, it may be noted that the financial assistance will be limited/entertained to the extent of budget availability in a financial year only.

The interested applicants, while submitting their applications for financial assistance, may kindly keep in mind the following instructions:

- i) Interested applicants are advised to forward their applications in respect of the above-mentioned schemes through online mode only. The Applications submitted through any other mode will not be entertained.
- ii) As per the guidelines of the above-mentioned schemes, interested applicants are required to submit hard copies of publications/books/necessary documents etc., alongwith hard copy of their filled in online application duly certified by the Competent Authority. All pages of application and annexures should be signed in ink and self-attested.
- iii) After filling the online applications, hard Copy of the completed applications should invariably be sent separately by Registered post, within 20 days to "Registrar, Central Sanskrit University, 56-57, Institutional Area, Janakpuri, New Delhi 110058. Name of the scheme is to be superscribed on the top of envelop.
- iv) Before filling the application form, it is advised that the scheme guidelines be referred thoroughly.

- vi) In each scheme, automatic renewal shall not be considered. Hence, it is mandatory for all grantee institutions of previous years to apply afresh for each scheme, as per schematic norms.
- vii) Further, consideration or rejection of the application for financial assistancewill depend upon the availability of funds and approval of the GIAC etc., as per schematic norms. Therefore, it is mandatory to apply every year onscheme-to-scheme basis separately for financial assistance.
