With regard to the entrance examination of Shiksha-Shastri (B.Ed.) paper code PGQP09 conducted by the NTA, it is to inform that as per the instructions of NTA the percentile should be used for drawing the merit list and not raw marks for the counseling process. Hence, the candidates who have obtained a minimum of 36 Percentile (108 marks) in the said examination have been considered eligible for admission in Shiksha-Shastri (B.Ed.) as decided by Central Sanskrit University.

Accordingly, considering the percentile as mentioned above (36 Percentile /108 marks) the total no of 2275 candidates are considered eligible against the fixed seats i.e. 715. Hence the fixed seats will be filled from these 2275 candidates only.
