The applicants are advised to note the following points:

1. Qualifications and other eligibility criteria for the posts will be the same as per UGC/ Govt. of India norms/Regulations on Recruitment Rules of CSU/Ordinances. Further, any amendments shall be strictly in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the UGC/ Govt. of India norms / Regulations on Recruitment Rules of CSU/Ordinances, from time to time.
2. As per UGC (Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and other Measures for the Maintenance of standards in Higher Education) Amendment Regulations, 2021, the date of applicability of Ph.D degree as mandatory qualification for direct recruitment of Assistant Professors has been extended from 01.07.2021 to 01.07.2023.
3. These vacant teaching and other academic posts will be filled up through Direct Recruitment.

4. The candidates applying for the teaching posts in Shastric disciplines must have ability to teach in Sanskrit medium. **Out of the all advertised teaching posts, 04 posts to be filled up by "PwBD-VH(02), PwBD-HH(01) and PwBD -MD(01)" Categories as per the availability of eligible candidates. 5. The posts in the University are of All India Cadre and accordingly, appointments will be made at any Campus/HQ Office, as per requirement. Employment in CSU involves liability to serve in any of the CSU's Campus situated at different parts of the country.

11. The columns in the online application form can be expanded to furnish any further information.
12. The applicant will be solely responsible for the authenticity of the submitted information.
13. There is no upper age limit for the posts. However, the retirement age for the teaching posts is 65 years and for the posts of Assistant Librarian and Assistant Director (Physical Education) is 62 years as per existing UGC norms/Govt. of India.
14. If a candidate wants to apply for more than one post, he/she should make separate application for each post. He/she will have to pay application fee for each post separately.

- A. Good academic record, with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) at the Master's degree in Yoga or any other relevant subject, or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University.

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time.

OR

- B. - ii. Record of having represented the university/college at the inter-university/inter-collegiate competitions or the State and /or national championships.
- iii. 2. Applications/candidature of applicants are liable to be cancelled/rejected summarily at any stage of the recruitment process in the event of all or any of the following:

 - ii. Application made in the form other than the form uploaded in SAMARTH Portal in University's website www.sanskrit.nic.in.
 - iii. Any variation in the Signatures.
 - iv. Fee not paid as per instructions.
 - v. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Experience/Category Status as on the closing date.
 - vi. Incorrect information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.
