Note :- For objective examinations (CBT), 20 Minutes of additional time & for descriptive examination, 40 minutes of additional time will be given to the eligible PwBD candidates subject to fulfilment of conditions as per rules.

#### **CENTRES FOR CBT/WRITTEN EXAMINATIONS**

- 1. The Centre for CBT/Written examinations for all above posts except 'Lower Division Clerk' will be only **DELHI**.
- 2. There will be 04 centres for examination (Objective CBT) for the post of 'Lower Division Clerk' as mentioned hereunder. The Central Sanskrit University has fixed the centres for CBT/Written examination covering different states in the country based on the strength of the applicants. The centre of CBT/Written examination will be allotted in respect of each candidate with regard to the communication address mentioned by the respective candidate in his/herapplication submitted through online. However, if any candidate wishes to opt centre of examination other than the allotted centre, shall submit his/her representation with proper justification, at support-recruitment@csu.co.in on or before 15-01-2023. Submission of representation through any other mode will not be entertained. Any representation after this date will not be considered in any case. Further, the change of the centre may be considered by the CSU subject to satisfaction of the reason mentioned by the candidate.

#### Important Information :-

- 1. The candidates can download their admit cards from 'Samarth' portal with their login credentials at https://sanskritnt.samarth.edu.in available in Central Sanskrit University, Delhi Website: www.sanskrit.nic.in from 21-01-2023. The admit cards will not be sent by post or any other mode.
- 2. The detailed selection criteria and scheme of examination/syllabi for each post are uploaded alongwith this notification on the University website.
- 3. The list of candidates who have successfully submitted their applications for different posts in response to the notification dated 18.10.2022 alongwith allotted region of examination centre, are uploaded with this notification, on the University website.
- 4. Examination centre with complete address will be given at relevant space in Hall ticket/Admit card.
- Representations regarding his/her candidature, region etc., in the candidates list, if any, and also any other assistance, the candidate may submit the representation at <a href="mailto:support-recruitment@csu.co.in">support-recruitment@csu.co.in</a>. Submission of representation through any other mode will not be entertained. Any representation after this date will not be entertained in any case.
- 6. Candidates are required to attend the examination centre, with valid ID card (issued by the Govt.) and Admit Card, 01 hour before the scheduled time of examination. No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre after reporting time under any circumstances.
- 7. Admit Card is being issued provisionally, on the basis of information furnished by the candidate in his/her application. The University has not verified/scrutinised his/her information and therefore, mere appearance in the examination/skill test does not, in any way, entitle him/her to claim for the post.
- 8. The candidates qualifying the CBT/Written examination will be eligible for skill test/interview, wherever applicable. List of those qualified candidates and schedule of skill test/interview, wherever applicable, will be displayed in University's website.
- 9. TA/DA will be admissible to the candidate for attending the examination/skill test/interview, and will be paid by concerned campus, as per rules.
- 10. Electronic gadgets are not allowed in the examination centre and candidates are requested to ensure and secure their belongings.
- 11. University reserves the right to debar any candidate from the examination, if found mischievous at any stage.
- 12. The duration of Examination in respect of PwBD candidates, wherever applicable, will be in accordance with the provisions of Govt. of India, as already mentioned in the detailed advertisements published in website of the Central Sanskrit University, Delhi. In such cases the eligible candidates should submit their representations regarding detail of scribe/reader/lab assistant, alongwith medical certificate duly certified by the Competent Authority, on or before 25.01.2023.
- 13. Candidates are also advised to regularly visit University's website: <u>www.sanskrit.nic.in</u> for schedule of CBT/Written/skill test, any change of the date of CBT/Written examination or centre of examination or further important announcements/information/corrigendum/notices and other details. Any communication will not be sent individually.

- 14. The decision of the University is final in all matters relating to eligibility, acceptance or rejection of the applications, penalty for false information, mode of selection, conduct of examination, allotment of examination centres and selection, as per rules.
- 15. For any technical issues while attending paper -1 (CBT)/Skill tests, alternative arrangements will be provided immediately.
- 16. In view of any delay in completion of the examination process due to unavoidable circumstances, the candidates are advised to make the arrangements for return journey accordingly.
- 17. In case of any dispute, any suite or legal proceeding against the University, the territorial jurisdiction shall be Hon'ble Courts in Delhi.
