### VISION OF THE SCHEMES

- Sanskrit, containing vast treasures of mathematics, philosophy, grammar, music, politics, medicine, architecture, metallurgy, drama, poetry, storytelling, and more (known as 'Sanskrit Knowledge Systems').
   These Sanskrit Knowledge Systems would be taught in ways in Simple Standard Sanskrit (SSS).
- To teach Sanskrit through Sanskrit (STS) and make its study truly enjoyable.
- Support and patronage should be extended to important active private academies and bodies which are working for the popularization of Sanskrit in their respective regions.
- To bring qualitative change in Sanskrit Education through research.
- To use new methods of imparting Sanskrit Education with the help of modern tools and technologies.

### Introduction

Sanskrit has played a vital role in the development of all Indian languages and in the preservation of the cultural heritage of India. It becomes essential to preserve and propagate Sanskrit for all-round development of India. The Sanskrit Commission, appointed by the Government of India in 1956, has recommended that support and patronage should be extended to important active private academies and bodies which are working for the popularization of Sanskrit in their respective regions.

The Government of India, in pursuance of the recommendations of the Sanskrit Commission (1956-57) constituted a Central Sanskrit Board, which recommended the establishment of aRashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan. The Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan was established in 15thOctober, 1970 as an autonomous organisation registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (Act XXI of 1860) for the Development and Promotion of Sanskrit at all over the country. It has been declared as Central Sanskrit University, Delhi (CSU) since 30th April, 2020 through an act passed by Parliament of India. It functions as an apex body for propagation and development of Sanskrit and assists the Ministry of Education in formulating and implementing various plans and Central Schemes for the promotion and development of Sanskrit studies.



The Government of India has introduced various Central Schemes for the promotion of Sanskrit by way of extending financial assistance to the applicants falling under respective schemes. These schemes were stand transferred alongwith budget provisions to Central Sanskrit University, Delhi (formerly Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan(RSkS)) for their execution and implementation on the recommendations of duly constituted Grants-in-Aid Committee (GIAC). After the transfer of various schemes from time to time (in 1979, 1986, 1991, 1995 and 2006), they were last revised in year 2007. Further, the schemes for 'Pali & Prakrit'since 2009 and Ashtaadashi (18 Projects) since 2016 are also implemented by Central Sanskrit University as per the directions of Ministry of Education. Currently, all 13 Central Schemes are being implemented through the Central Sanskrit Universityas the nodal agency of Ministry of Education, Government of India for overall promotion and development of Sanskrit language & education.

The following Schemes have been reviewed & revised by merging the various components of the Scheme for Development of Sanskrit Education with its Scheme for Financial Assistance to Voluntary Sanskrit Organizations, Institutions and Pathshalas for Promotion of Sanskrit during the year 2007-08. These reviewed Schemes were renamed as 'Scheme for Development of Sanskrit Education'. These schemes were reviewed and revised from time to time as per Government norms and now renamed as "Scheme for Promotion of Sanskrit". The revised guidelines for the Schemes have been approved by the Ministry of Education on 30.09.2022.

### Financial Assistance for Sanskrit Teaching




This scheme having five parts as mentioned below i.e. (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e)

- (a) Engaging Sanskrit Teachers to the Traditional Sanskrit Pathshalas/Mahavidyalayas.
- (b) Engaging Modern Subject Teachers in Traditional Sanskrit Pathshalas/Mahavidyalayas.
- (c) Engaging Sanskrit Teachers in State Government Schools.
- (d) Engaging Sanskrit Teachers under Chatuspathi Institutions.
- (e) Residential Scholarships to Sanskrit Students.

#### Introduction

The Financial Assistance under this scheme will be restricted to Traditional Sanskrit Pathshala/Mahavidyalaya imparting Sanskrit teaching on traditional lines only. The purpose of the scheme is to provide financial assistance to the Voluntary Sanskrit Organisations/Oriental Schools, Institutions and Pathshalas for Sanskrit/Modern subject teachers and Government Aided High/Higher Secondary Schools for Sanskrit subject teachers, where the institutions, parent bodies and State Governments are not in a position to provide such facilities.




#### **Objectives**


- To make the traditional study of Sanskrit more purposeful from the point of view of acceptability and employability of the students passing out of Pathshalas/Mahavidyalayas and to bring about fusion between the traditional and modern systems of Sanskrit education.
- To encourage the students to pursue a course of study in traditional Sanskrit Pathshalas / Mahavidyalayas withtraditional facilities to learn modern subjects.
- All the Sanskrit teachers, getting grants from the Central Schemes, should teach Sanskrit through Sanskrit medium with Simple Standard Sanskrit as per guidelines of NEP-2020.

#### Special Achievements


- Central Sanskrit University, Delhi has first time implemented the online system for Central Schemes from the year 2022-23.

### Samman Rashi to Eminent Sanskrit Pandits




#### Intoduction


#### The scheme has following objectives:



















## Publication, Bulk Purchase and Re-print of Rare Sanskrit Books



#### Introduction

A large number of rare books which are in the form of ancient palm leaves, manuscripts etc., require to be converted into text form and published. These books hold great value hence they are very much essential for higher learning of Sanskrit Shastras. Under this scheme, preference shall be given to publications which are purely written in Sanskrit and grammatically accurate.

This scheme having three parts as mentioned below i.e. (a), (b) and (c)

- (a) Publication of Sanskrit Literature and Sanskrit Journal
- (b) Bulk Purchase of Sanskrit Books
- (c) Re-print of rare Sanskrit books



#### Objective

The objective of the scheme is to encourage the authors/publishers in the field of Sanskrit for creation of Sanskrit Literature and Journals for propagation and preservation of Sanskrit language by providing the financial assistance. This would also ensure the availability of Sanskrit books and journals in all libraries of Sanskrit institutions.

#### Scope -


The following kinds of publications are eligible for consideration under thi Scheme:-

- i) Sanskrit books of reference like encyclopedias, anthologies and compilations,
- ii) bibliographies and dictionaries.
- ii) Descriptive catalogues of Sanskrit manuscripts
- iii) Self-learning instructions for Sanskrit
- iv) Original writing in Sanskrit on linguistics, literary, Indological, Social, Anthropological and cultural themes.
- v) Critical edition and/or publication of old Sanskrit manuscripts
- vi) Transliteration and publication of classics into Sanskrit
- vii) Reprint/revised edition of rare Sanskrit books



#### Baneficiaries of last 6 years








#### The main objectives of this scheme are:


- To preserve the in depth study of various Shastric subjects in Sanskrit at various centers, where traditional system of Sanskrit education is being imparted to students.

This scheme provides additional support skills to Sanskrit Students and scholars. Sanskrit scholars can be made more employable, either through alternative job placement or through self-employment. The objective of


the scheme is to promote vocational system of education amongst Sanskrit knowing youngsters. While adequate attention has been given to the formal education system, the same given to the promotion of vocational system of education, especially in Sanskrit, has been insignificant although it has large employment potential.

- Rich Manuscripts Libraries in the country, which getting patronage the are increasing from Governments the Department State and Culture, Government of India, requirelarge number of Sanskrit knowing youngsters to take up jobs of cataloguers, editors, translators, manuscriptologists, palacographists and copyists
- Museums, Epigraphic Departments, Archaeological Departments, Tourist Department and Institutions specializing in historical research also need the services of Sanskrit students who have a special aptitude for the respective jobs
- Printing Industry is suffering from dearth of qualified Sanskrit composers and the Society at large does not have enough qualified persons in Karma Kanda
- All the Vocational Courses recognized by National Council for Vocational Education and Training (NCVET), Recognized skill courses by Skill Council, etc. may be offered through Sanskrit/bilingual to Sanskrit students.




#### INTRODUCTION

#### INTRODUCTION

The Scheme for the Award of the Certificate of Honour to the scholars of Sanskrit, Arabic and Persian Languages was introduced by the Government of India in the year 1958. After 1990, the same scheme was transferred in 1991 vide letter dated 26.4.1991 by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India to Central Sanskrit University, (formerly Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan), Delhi thereafter, the scheme is being implemented from 1991 by Central Sanskrit University, Delhi as nodal agency.

The Scheme was extended to cover scholars of Pali and Prakrit in year 1996. Further, from the year 2016 onwards, the scheme has been extended to award Presidential Award of Certificate of Honour for four Classical Languages namely, Classical Oriya, Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu and Classical Malayalam with objective to promote classical languages. Presidential Award of Certificate of Honour is awarded to the scholars of eminence over 60 years of age with outstanding contribution in the field of respective languages. Under this scheme, there are 15 awards for Sanskrit scholars of the Country & one for International Sanskrit scholar, one award each for Pali & Prakrit scholars, 3 awards each for Arabic and Persian scholars, one award each for scholars of the country alongwith 2 International award of Certificates of Honour to the scholars of each of Classical Kannada, Classical Telugu, Classical Oriya and Classical Malyalam. This scheme envisages a one-time cash award of Rs. 5 lakh with Certificate and a Shawl to each awardee.

In addition, the Scheme also provides for the Maharshi Badrayan Vyas Samman for young scholars in the age group of 30 to 45 years in the field of Sanskrit, Pali, Prakrit, Arabic, Persian, Classical Oriya, Classical Kannada, Telugu Classical and Classical Malayalam. There are five Awards for Young Sanskrit Scholars, one award each for young scholars of Pali, Prakrit, Arabic & Persian languages and five awards each for four young scholars of four classical languages. Under the scheme, Rs. 1 lakh with Certificate and a Shawl are given to each awardee.

The distinction is conferred on the eve of Independence Day every year by Hon'ble President of India.

# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ADARSH SANSKRIT MAHAVIDYALAYAS / ADARSH SHODHA SANSTHANS

### Introduction

The Scheme for Establishment of Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalayas / Shodha Sansthans was started by the Government of India for supporting traditional institutions of Sanskrit learning. The Scheme was revised in 1983 vide Ministry of Human Resource Development (Now MoE), Government of India letter no.F.80-7/88-Sk. dated 06.10.1983. Then it was revised in 1993 vide Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India and renamed as "The Scheme for financial assistance to Institutions recognized as Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalyas/Adarsh Shodha Sansthans". Later, the Scheme was transferred to the Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan (Now Central Sanskrit University) for implementation in 1995 by the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development (Now MoE), Government of India.


As per directions of the MoE, Govt. of India, the scheme was further revised by a duly constituted committee in the year 2017, keeping in view of several developments such as issue of UGC Regulations - 2018, conversion of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan into a Central Sanskrit University, implementation of the recommendations contained in NEP-2020 etc.

The draft of the scheme was further revised/modified by duly constituted high level committee and the draft of revised guidelines of "The Scheme for Financial Assistance to Institutions recognized as Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalayas/Adarsh Sanskrit Shodh Sansthans (ASMs/ASSSs)-2022"


prepared by the High Level Committee was forwarded to the Ministry of Education for approval. The approval has been given by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education vide letter F.No. 1-5/2017-Skt.I(Vol.III) dated 24.03.2023. The further decision on the approved Scheme will be taken after placing the same in the Executive Council of the Central Sanskrit University, Delhi.

Under this scheme, 26 Institutions recognized as Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalayas(ASMs)/Adarsh Shodha Sansthans(ASSs) are being run at various parts of the country with the financial assistance of Govt. of India through the Central Sanskrit University(CSU) at present and major portion of the finance for this scheme is being released by the CSU. Out of these recognised institutions, there are 22 ASMs & 04 ASSs. These institutions are financially assisted to the extent of the 95% of the admissible expenditure for recurring item and to the extent of 75% for non-recurring items subject to the maximum of Rs.5.00 lakh per annum relating to development of infrastructure.

The objective of the Scheme is to support and promote traditional Sanskrit learning and research. For this purpose, assistance is extended under this scheme to Sanskrit Mahavidyalayas for conducting courses at the level of Shastri and Acharya and to Shodha Sansthans (Research Institution) for organizing and conducting research – both at doctoral & post doctoral levels and bringing out research based publications and Research Journals.






#### Introduction

The Poornaprajna Samshodhana Mandiram (PPSM), the companion institution, mentioned above, is the other brain-child of H.H. Sri Vishveshatirtha Swamiji, and was started by him in 1988. This pioneering Sanskrit research institute aims to enable the serious academic study of those interested in Sanskrit literature, as a part of upholding Swamiji's vision of preserving and propagating the rich cultural and textual heritage of Indian philosophy. As a part of its activities in furtherance of this goal, the PPSM has gathered and carefully preserved a significant collection of rare manuscripts, books, and publishes many rare works in Sanskrit, Kannada, and English, some never before seen in print.

The Human Resource Development (HRD) Ministry of the Government of India recognised the PPSM as a model Research Institute, and included it in the prestigious group of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Samsthan (Deemed University) in 1994. The HRD Ministry sanctioned financial assistance of 95% grant through the Rashtriya Sanskrit Samsthan. This aid is gratefully acknowledged, and is being diligently utilised for meeting the purpose intended. Now Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan become Central Sanskrit University.

Post P.G. students can enroll for Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) courses here. Already more than 57 students awarded Ph.D. from CSU (RSkS) through the PPSM centre.




