Subject: **Conversion of CGPA to Percentage -regarding.**

All concerned are informed that, as per Ordinance No. 39 (19.v.e.) of Central Sanskrit University the following formula will be used for converting CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) into percentage for all the examinations conducted by the University-

CGPA × 10 = Marks Percentage

This conversion formula applies to all examinations conducted by the University, and the resultant percentage will reflect the overall academic performance of the candidate based on their CGPA.

Example: If a candidate has a CGPA of 7.5, the percentage will be calculated as follows: $7.5 \times 10 = 75\%$.

In the context of the above, if the students require any kind of certificate, it is informed to all such students to contact the concerned campus/institution.
