**Subject: Clarification regarding the Medium of Examination for Written Test
(Step-3 a)**

With reference to Advertisement No. 02/2025 (dated 20.11.2025) and the subsequent syllabus updates uploaded on 12.01.2026 and Selection Criteria and Scheme of Examination uploaded on 06.02.2026, this notice provides essential clarification for all concerned applicants regarding the written assessment which is designed to general assessment of language expression, subject knowledge, and research aptitude.

In this reference, the following language mandates must be strictly observed:

- **Sanskrit Shastra/Research (Darshan/Sanskrit) Posts:** It is mandatory for candidates applied for Sanskrit Shastras/Research (Darshan/Sanskrit) to write all answers (Essay and Short Answers) in the Sanskrit language only.
- **Other Language Posts:** The medium of answering shall be the specific language for which the candidate has applied (e.g., Hindi for Hindi post, English for English post, Manipuri for Manipuri post and Tamil for Tamil Post).
- **College Librarian Post:** Candidates appearing for the post of College Librarian have the flexibility to write their answers in either Hindi or English.

All other terms, conditions, details, and instructions contained in the Advertisement, Selection Criteria and Scheme of Examination, Syllabus for the Examination, and other notifications issued in this regard shall apply accordingly.
