Appointment of Vice-Chancellor of Central Sanskrit University, Delhi

Applications are invited for the post of **Vice-Chancellor of Central Sanskrit University, Delhi**. The Vice-Chancellor, being the academic as well as administrative head, is expected to be:

- i. An eminent scholar in the field of Sanskrit and allied subjects and his qualifications shall be as specified in the regulations made under the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956) in this behalf.
- ii. Preferably not more than 65 years of age as on the closing date of receipt of applications of this advertisement.
- iii. A person possessing the highest level of competence, integrity, morals and institutional commitment.
- iv. A distinguished academician, with a minimum of 10 years' experience as Professor in a University or 10 years' experience in a reputed research and/or academic administrative organization with proof of having demonstrated academic leadership.

Salary and Service Conditions

- The post carries a pay of Rs. 2,10,000/- (Fixed) per month with Special Allowance of Rs. 11,250/- and other usual allowances.
- The other terms and conditions of the services will be those as set forth in the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 and Statutes and Ordinances of the University.

Procedure for appointment

- Appointment will be made from a panel of three names recommended by a Selection Committee in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020.


